

Fulfilling Your Certification Requirements

As a result of Assembly bill #2527, which was signed into law on April 25, 1991, all individuals who perform on-site services on underground storage tank systems must be certified by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and must renew their certification every three years.

To aid individuals in becoming certified, the New Jersey Society of Professional Engineers, in conjunction with the NJDEP, sponsors this seminar to satisfy one of the requirements of this new law. This seminar will cover the current NJDEP rules and regulations for UST systems.

This course satisfies the requirements of P.L. 1991, c.123, for attendance at a department-approved training course on the department's rules and regulations concerning underground storage tanks.

Recertification Every 3 Years

Certification shall be for a three year period. Renewal of a certification, or recertification, shall be made to the department at least 60 days prior to the expiration date of the certification, and shall be accompanied by evidence of attendance at a department approved training course, within the preceding 12 months, on the department's rules and regulations concerning underground storage tanks.

The law was passed in April of 1991. Our first course was held in May of 1991. Please check your certification date to see if you need to be recertified.

No professional engineer will be permitted to perform on-site work on UST systems without certification.
